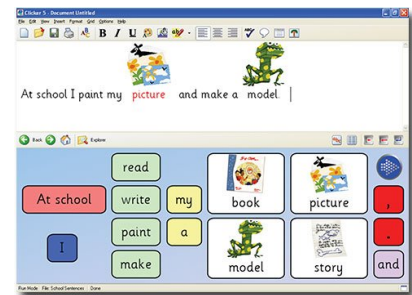


ICT Taster – Try Before You Buy

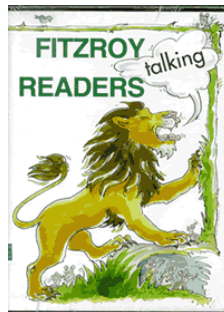
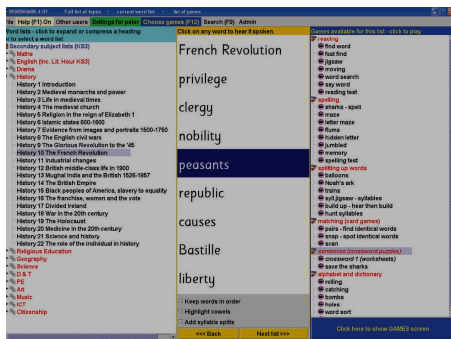
Software to support children with literacy and numeracy difficulties
