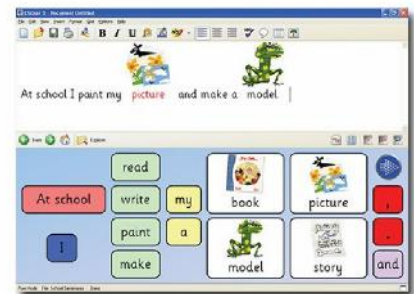
Software to support children with literacy and numeracy difficulties

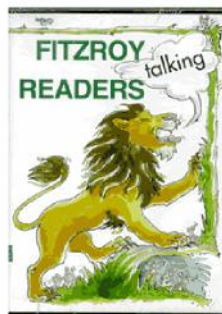
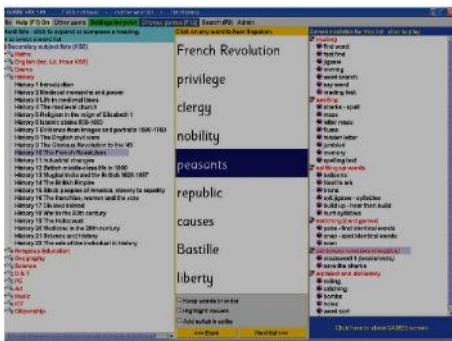
